REGIONAL FONOMIC GENERATOR

San Diego County's Franchised New Car Dealers

remained a significant regional economic generator in 2023, showing improvements in nearly every category over 2022. Sales revenue from new and used vehicles increased for the third consecutive year, and combined with revenue increases from service and parts sales, total dealership sales reached more than \$14.3 billion – resulting in \$1.3 billion in taxes and fees. San Diego County dealers employed more than 12,000 full and part time employees in 2023 with a payroll exceeding \$1.2 billion for the second year in a row. Additionally, dealers made purchases from other California businesses totaling more than \$266 million.

The extraordinary economic impact of San Diego County's 120+ franchised new car dealers is spread throughout the region, with dealerships located in every major municipality, including: Carlsbad, Chula Vista, El Cajon, Encinitas, Escondido, La Jolla, La Mesa, Lemon Grove, National City, Oceanside, Pacific Beach, Poway, San Diego and Vista.
